



2019 COLIBRI GRENACHE PICK 2

Colibri Vineyards, located in east-west running Whitetail canyon in the Chiricahua Mountains, is as stunning as its wines are interesting. Remote and beautiful, Colibri sits in a wild and ancient volcanic landscape. To our knowledge, no other winery immortalizes the specific pick number on the bottle. Since PSC's inception, we have always felt that wines crafted at different ripeness levels (sequential picks) give us a greater array of expressions from any particular block and variety. While we enjoy having a greater diversity of wines to blend with, at times a single variety, single pick, is often great enough to bottle on its own. More often than not, Colibri Grenache gives us just that.
