



## 2020 HOUSE MOUNTAIN PINOT NOIR

We have been chasing the holy “Pinot” grail for many years now. Pinot’s homeland of Burgundy, France is cooler than many of our growing regions so we have sought out cool microclimates to grow this fickle grape in. This year we split the batch and fermented half in our classic, small open top fermenters and the other half in oak barrels lying on end with one of the heads removed. The wines were surprisingly different, and when blended made this classic, complex wine. Unmistakably Pinot!
