



## 2021 COLIBRI MOURVÈDRE

We are fortunate that the Mourvèdre crop from Colibri comes in *every* year. Being the latest variety, it flowers two-to-three weeks later than the Grenache and Syrah planted at the site. In years when frost threatens, this grape presents lower risk because it comes out so late. This particular batch was fermented to create a lighter, more fruit forward wine and should be enjoyed earlier than its predecessors and counterparts. It still has all the hallmark Colibri earthiness, rusticity and spice, but has a brighter red and purple fruit driven palate.
