



2022 BRUZZI VIDAL BLANC PICK 1

This wine not only comes from the first Vidal Blanc planted in Arizona, but also the first wine-grapes to come from high elevation Gila County. It's exciting to see viticultural efforts charting new territory and revealing amazing new possibilities for Arizona. The Bruzzi Vineyard is farmed by the father and son team of James and Aldo Bruzzi. They could not have picked a better grape for their site. Vidal, bred from Ugni Blanc (the main grape used in Cognac) and the cold hardy Rayon d'Or, emerges late and ripens quickly. It can survive severe winters and if it gets frosted, puts out a good second crop. On one hand, this will remind you of the fruit cups of your childhood, Rainier cherries, and ripe pears. On the other, prominent characters of baking soda, limestone and wet cement streak through this wine. There is a magnificent synergy of fruit and stone here that will excite wine drinkers new and old!
